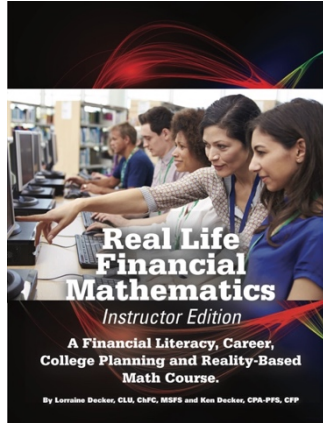


RLFM Educators' Conference

This unique, exciting four-day conference provides 35 hours of professional development, specifically designed for educators launching, instructing, or measuring the outcomes from **REAL LIFE FINANCIAL MATHEMATICS (RLFM)**.

You will learn so much and experience – state of the art instructional methodology and course content that will change the future of your students, families and community. You will understand why people say, “*This is the course I wish I had in high school.*”

What to Expect?

Intense, fun, engaging, professional level learning experience.

Pre-Conference Prep – Great videos to watch and you will register using a process similar to what your students will experience. You will also take the **RLFM** first semester and final exam so you will know what you know and don’t know. BTW – We don’t expect you to pass. If you ace the exam, we will be incredibly impressed! If you don’t, we will include these topics in Day 3 training. (3 hours CPE).

Day One – As you step into the classroom, you time travel to age 16 and experience two lessons as mature high school students – 1) Financial Planning – Focus on Emergency Funding, Retirement, & Financial Independence and 2) Advanced Math. You then work in teams to analyze pre-conference prep videos and their foundation for **RLFM**’s unique instructional design. You will understand how to engage brain development through blended online learning using 6E pedagogy. (7 hours CPE). After class, educators reflect on why & how they can modify modeling teaching methodology to become a **Real Life** educator (1 hour CPE).

Day Two – Five learning objectives: 1) Canvas LMS technology, 2) How to work with student teams, presentations and avoiding detours, 3) Community engagement, 4) How to use student data to create individual student expectations and outcomes, and 5) Course management. (7 hours CPE). After class, educators analyze sample student data to set individual expectations. (1 hour CPE).

Day Three – Increase your course knowledge – review of pre-course exams, taxes, finances, career discovery, postsecondary education. Evening get together! (7 hours CPE)

Day Four – Teams select and present favorite **RLFM** lessons. Everyone participates and applies the new instructional design. While team presents, those not presenting are engaged as questioning students and evaluating lessons. (7 hours CPE).

Post Conference - The growth continues with educators completing the evaluation and course exam. (2 hours CPE)
